Policy 124: CSUS Board Policy Naming University Properties, Academic and Non-Academic Programs and Facilities

Board Policy

Approval of the naming of University properties, academic and non-academic programs, and facilities for the Colorado State University System institutions is vested with the Board of Governors. The administration of this policy is delegated to the Chancellor of the Colorado State University System.

Naming

The President of Colorado State University, Colorado State University-Pueblo or Colorado State University Global Campus, respectively, may request Board approval for a naming of institutional properties, academic and non-academic programs, facilities and structures in honor of persons or entities that have made important contributions to enable the teaching, research and public service mission of the university. All namings in recognition of an honoree must be consistent with institutional policies governing such recognition and

- B. A proposal for naming shall include documentation of the following:
1. A thorough analysis of the proposal in relation to naming policy and guidelines;
 2. A financial review of the gift if any;
 3. Review by the CSUS General Counsel.
